Graded Agency:

U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) small business program achievements consistently exceed federal-wide and USDA goals for small, small disadvantaged, HUBZone, and Women-owned business categories. USDA Service Disabled Veteran-owned (SDVOSB) program efforts have led to increasing accomplishments positioning USDA close to also achieving the SDVOSB goal.

USDA facilitates the economic growth and competitive posture of small rural businesses and small farmer-owned cooperatives through outreach and technical assistance to them for participation in USDA procurements. USDA's commitment to increased access to contracting opportunities by small and disadvantaged businesses in rural areas will stimulate small business ownership and economic growth, create jobs, and result in improving the quality of life across America.

SBA:

Goaling Achievement

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) met 4 of their 5 prime contracting goals missing Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business.

Fiscal year 2009 prime contracting achievement saw increases over FY2008 in Small Disadvantaged Business, Service-Disable Veteran Owned Small Business, and HUBZone. USDA FY2009 achievement declined for Small Business and Women Owned Small Business.

USDA responded late to SBA's contracting data anomaly report and partially addressed submitted anomalies.
